Habitat for Humanity Peterborough & Kawartha Region is looking for a Community Engagement Coordinator to join our team for a one-year contract (with a strong chance of renewal). Reporting to the Director of Philanthropy & Communications, you will be a key player in ensuring quality experiences for all volunteers.



The successful candidate for this role will be responsible for managing all of Habitat Peterborough & Kawartha Region's volunteer activities and will work collaboratively with other team members across the organization to achieve volunteer targets by delivering our volunteer outreach, engagement and retention strategies.

This position requires the ability to manage diverse and complex administrative, communications, and organization tasks with speed, accuracy, discretion, and clarity, while maintaining a focus on the mission of the organization always.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

As a valued member of our team and in order to ensure we get more people into decent, affordable homes, you will:

- > Manage the entire volunteer program, including recruitment, interviews, training, scheduling, logistics, and stewardship.
- Provide informative and engaging presentations to varying types and sizes of audiences in the community as part of your recruitment and outreach strategy.
- > Build or strengthen community relationships that will expand the volunteer pool to secure a reliable source of volunteers to support our operations.
- Orient new volunteers to Habitat Peterborough & Kawartha Region's mission, goals, staff, and operations.
- Create and maintain a welcoming and inclusive environment for all new and existing volunteers, including creating job descriptions and reviewing annually.
- > Develop strong relationships and work closely with each department to ensure volunteer needs are being met, and together you will create an environment that ensures a consistent and rewarding volunteer experience.
- Coordinate build site hosting programs and logistics, including the Youth, Corporate, and Women Build Programs.
- > Responsible for working with Women Build Program participants to achieve fundraising goals and provide guidance.
- Secure corporate product donations to support volunteer recognition program, special events and other initiatives.
- Manage communications with volunteers including creation of a monthly volunteer enewsletter, creating posters, ads, e-blasts, etc. to engage the community.
- Track volunteer activity, years of service, hours, and contact information.
- > Nominate volunteers for municipal, provincial, and other awards.
- Ensure engagement of the volunteer community in all Habitat Peterborough & Kawartha Region activities.



- Be a Habitat Brand ambassador as you recruit in the community and organize and participate in general, community and volunteer appreciation events.
- Connect regularly with our volunteer community to learn from them what brought them to Habitat Peterborough & Kawartha Region and what keeps them volunteering.
- Ensure from start to finish all volunteer requirements are completed to the highest standards, ensuring volunteers have the best experience possible that inspires them to tell others to consider volunteering with Habitat.
