Under the supervision of the ReStore Manager, the ReStore Sales Associate will be tasked with daily operations of the retail store including:

- Testing and processing goods
- Operating a cash register
- Communicating with customers in person, virtually and on the phone
- Organizing and delegating volunteers for tasks
- Generating sales
- Safeguarding company assets
