In this role, you will have a chance to give back to your community by working for an environmentally conscious not-for-profit organization that raises funds to support the building of safe, decent, and affordable homes in your community. No two days are the same.

#### **The Role**

This is a great opportunity to be part of a positive retail experience and gain valuable customer service, teamwork, sales, health and safety, and merchandising skills. The ReStore Associate will be tasked with assisting with daily operations of the ReStore, including:

- Providing customer service, greeting and welcoming customers and donors
- Performing point of sale, sales floor, loading dock, and sales duties
- · Accepting donations of new and gently-used goods, including unloading, lifting/moving
- Completing cash/credit transactions and administering paperwork
- Communicating with customers and volunteers in person, digitally, and on the phone
- Working daily to ensure all sales are maximized
- Testing, processing, pricing, and merchandising product aesthetically
- Maintaining health and safety and safeguarding standards
