

Rules & Regulations

Habitat for Humanity Peterborough & Kawartha Region is excited to announce our Summer Online 50/50 fundraiser! The lottery is licensed by, and will follow the rules set out by, the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).

1. Players of this lottery must reside in Ontario and be 18 years of age or older. Tickets must be purchased by major credit card with an Ontario address.

2. Tickets will be sold online only using an electronic raffle system supplied by Rafflebox.

3. No tickets can be purchased by any of the employee(s) of Habitat for Humanity Peterborough & Kawartha Region or by any person assigned/involved with the administration and management of the prescribed 50/50 gaming event(s). This includes all employees of the ReStore locations in Peterborough, Lakefield, and Lindsay. Nor is an employees' spouse eligible to buy tickets. **Only Habitat for Humanity Peterborough & Kawartha Region volunteers are eligible to purchase tickets.** Habitat for Humanity Peterborough & Kawartha Region board members including their spouses/partners, and any related or dependent person residing in the same household are prohibited from purchasing a ticket in this lottery.

4. The Licensee reserves discretionary right not to accept entries.

5. The Purchaser is responsible for proof-of-ownership of shared tickets.

6. Tickets will be sold at a rate of 5 for \$10; 30 for \$20; 150 for \$50; and 300 for \$75. The number of tickets sold will be unlimited.

7. The Draw will be held at 11:00 am EST on August 29, 2025.

8. Tickets will be sold between the dates of June 20, 2025 and August 28, 2025 inclusive.

9. The Draw will take place at Habitat for Humanity Peterborough & Kawartha Region, 300 Milroy Drive, Peterborough, Ontario, K9H 7M9. There will be one winner. The prize amount will be 50% of the ticket sales and will be updated in real time on the lottery website.





10. The winner will be determined using random-number generation. Results will be announced on social media following the draw, and the winner will be contacted by phone or email.

11. Winners must arrange to collect their prize in person at Habitat for Humanity Peterborough & Kawartha Region. At this time, the winner must provide their phone number, address, a piece of photo ID, and the email receipt with their winning lottery ticket number on it.

12. Once a winner is verified, they will be awarded their prize by cheque and have their photograph taken. By purchasing a ticket, each purchaser agrees to allow Habitat for Humanity Peterborough & Kawartha Region to use purchaser's name and image without compensation for any promotional activity related to this or any future raffle.

13. The winning ticket holder has 6 months from the draw date to claim their prize. Unclaimed prizes will be reported to AGCO, and a charitable allocation will be approved by AGCO.

14. Tickets may be sold and purchased only in Ontario.
